The answer

Named in 47 of the 194 responses we could read.

Roughly one ask in four returns your name. The other three name someone else, most often a clinic within four kilometres of you. Where you are named, it is usually because the person asked for you by name.

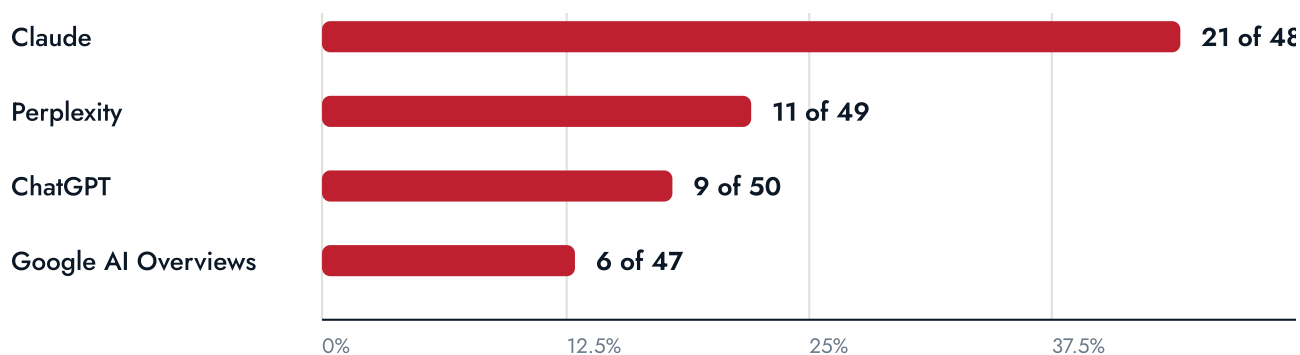

SECTION TWO

How we tested

We wrote ten prompts of the kind a person actually types when they are looking to book, not the kind a marketer would choose. Eight are unbranded, two name you directly. Each was asked five times on each of four surfaces, giving 200 responses in total.

Five runs matter because AI answers vary between asks. The same question put twice can return two different sets of businesses, so a single ask proves nothing either way.

The ten prompts

1. Best physio in Kingsmere
2. Physiotherapist near Kingsmere for lower back pain
3. Who should I see for a running injury in Melbourne's inner north
4. Kingsmere Physiotherapy reviews
5. Best sports physio Melbourne inner north
6. Physio that does dry needling in Marlowe or Kingsmere
7. Is Kingsmere Physiotherapy any good
8. Physio open Saturday Kingsmere
9. NDIS physiotherapy provider inner north Melbourne
10. Best clinic for shoulder rehab Melbourne

Prompts shown in red name your business.

SECTION THREE

Prompt by prompt

A filled square means you were named at least once on that surface. A hollow square means you were not named there in any of the five runs.

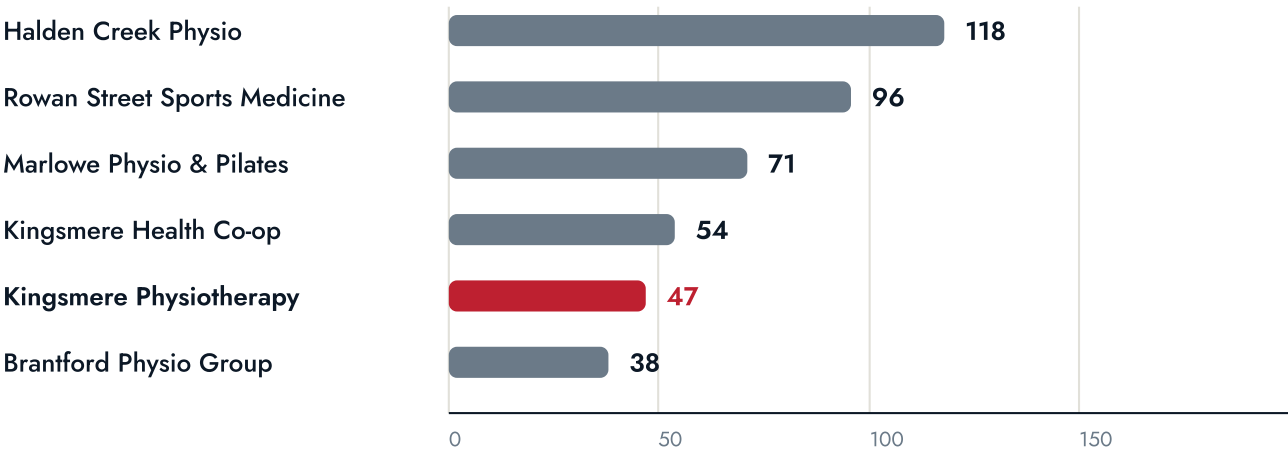
Of every business named, how many were you

A further 23 businesses were named fewer than 30 times each and are not shown. You place fifth of the six most-named clinics.

SECTION FIVE

Who gets named instead

Five clinics appear more often than you do or close behind. For each, the prompts where they were named and you were not.

Halden Creek Physio

Named in every unbranded prompt, and the only clinic named in all five runs of "best physio in Kingsmere" on all four surfaces. Consistently described as the inner north's default recommendation.

Rowan Street Sports Medicine

Dominates anything mentioning sport or running. Named in 19 of the 20 responses to "best sports physio Melbourne inner north", where you were named once.

Marlowe Physio & Pilates

The only clinic named for Saturday and after-hours appointments, appearing in 14 of the 18 responses to that prompt.

Kingsmere Health Co-op

Named in 17 of the 19 responses about NDIS and funded care, a prompt where you were not named at all.

Brantford Physio Group

Named less often than you overall, but reaches surfaces you do not. Appears in Google AI Overviews at nearly three times your rate there.

SECTION SIX

Where AI is getting its answers

When an assistant answers a question about local businesses, it usually reads a handful of web pages first and lists them underneath. Those are citations. The pages that get cited are, in effect, the sources AI trusts to know your industry, and being named on one of them is often how a business ends up in the answer.

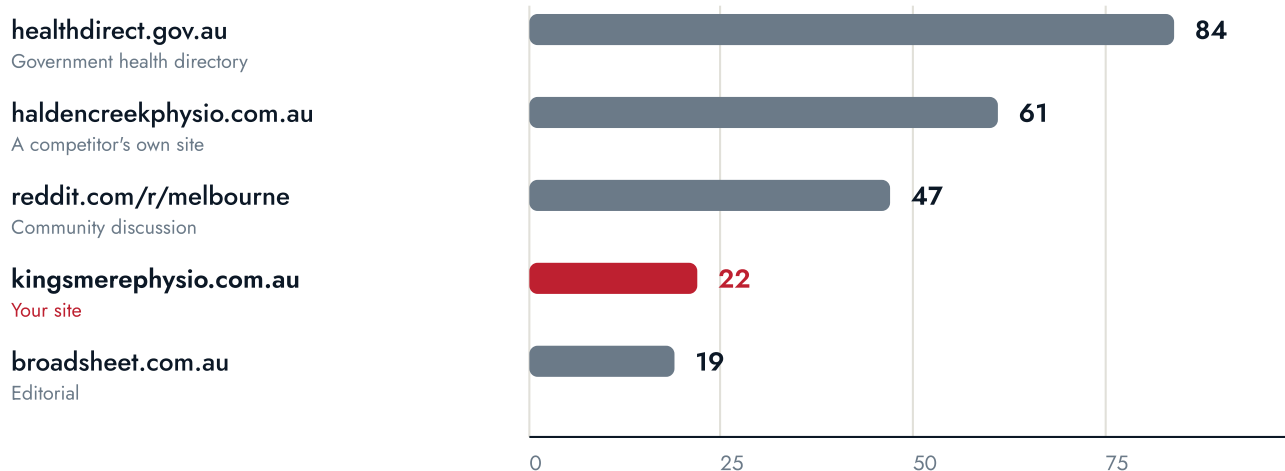

Two of the top three are pages you do not control but could appear on. Your own site is cited, which means AI can read it; it is simply reached for less often than the directories and discussions around you.

SECTION SEVEN

Three things to do next

Three distinct plays, not a ranked list. Each follows from a specific gap in the data above, and each names the prompts it would move.

AVAILABILITY

Get your Saturday hours somewhere AI can read them

Eighteen responses answered "physio open Saturday Kingsmere". You were named in none of them. Marlowe Physio & Pilates was named in fourteen, and in eleven of those the assistant cited a directory listing that stated their weekend hours explicitly.

Opening hours are one of the few facts an assistant will repeat verbatim when it can find them stated plainly. Where it cannot, it omits the business rather than guess. That is the likely mechanism here.

The work is to make your hours unambiguous and consistent on the third-party listings AI is already reading, starting with the health directory that carries the most citations in this data set.

Eleven citations naming a competitor's weekend hours

We measured what AI said, not what your website says. Confirm your Saturday hours before changing any listing.

FUNDED CARE

Say plainly whether you take NDIS participants

Nineteen responses answered "NDIS physiotherapy provider inner north Melbourne". You were named in none. Kingsmere Health Co-op was named in seventeen.

This is a high-intent question. A person asking it has funding in place and is choosing a provider, which makes the enquiry qualified before it reaches you. It is also the one prompt in this set where the assistants were most cautious, several declining to list any clinic they could not confirm as a registered provider.

If you do take NDIS participants, the fact needs to be stated where the provider directories and the assistants can find it. If you do not, this prompt is not worth pursuing and the effort belongs elsewhere.

SOURCES

Appear on the pages AI already reaches for

Your site was cited 22 times out of 486. The health directory was cited 84 times and the Melbourne community forum 47. Between them they carry more than a quarter of every citation in this data set, and neither requires anyone to visit your website first.

This is the slowest of the three plays and the one with the longest tail. A directory listing corrected once keeps working. An editorial mention keeps being cited long after it is published.

It is also the play that moves the unbranded prompts as a group rather than one at a time, because these sources are read across the whole prompt set rather than for any single question.

SECTION EIGHT

Method and limits

What was measured

Ten prompts, asked five times each on four surfaces between 4 August 2026 and 8 August 2026, from an Australian IP address with no signed-in account or prior conversation history. Every response was read and every business name in it recorded. A business is counted once per response in which it appears.

What was not measured

We did not look at your website, your Google Business Profile, your reviews or your rankings in conventional search. Nothing in this report is a judgement about your site or your marketing. Where a recommendation touches something on your side, it says so and asks you to confirm it.

AI answers are not fixed

These systems are non-deterministic. The same prompt asked twice can return different businesses, and the models themselves are updated without notice. Asking these ten prompts again next week would produce different numbers even if nothing about your business or anyone else's had changed. That is why each prompt was run five times rather than once, and why every figure here carries the number it was counted out of.

This is a snapshot, not a monitor

It describes one week in August 2026. It does not track change, it will not alert you if something shifts, and it should not be read as a trend. If you want to know whether the picture is moving, the same set of prompts has to be re-run on a schedule and compared.

Rounding

Percentages are rounded to the nearest whole number. Prompt-level results are printed as counts rather than percentages, because five runs per surface means a single response moves a prompt-level figure by 20 points and a percentage would imply a precision the method does not have.

SURFACES AND ACCESS

ChatGPT, Claude, Google AI Overviews and Perplexity, each with web search enabled.

CLAUDE DISCLOSURE

Claude was queried through Anthropic's API with web search enabled, not the consumer Claude app. Results from the two can differ.

COVERAGE

194 of 200 responses returned and were read. Six failed or timed out and are excluded from every figure in this report.

COMPETITOR SELECTION

Competitors were not chosen by us in advance. Every business named in any response was recorded, and the most frequently named are the ones reported.

Ongoing monitoring re-runs these same ten prompts every month on the same four surfaces, and sends you what changed. Same method, same counting rule, so the numbers are comparable month to month rather than a fresh snapshot each time.

It is the only way to tell whether the three plays in this report worked.
